Steve Bounous Scholarship Criteria

A group was formed to set the criteria for the Steve Bounous Scholarship Award. The essence of this award is to honor the best skier in IMD. This is a performance award. The criteria is as follows:

- Requires 2 Years competing in IMD
- Use World Rank using FIS points with a "good citizen" component
- Use the average of the best 2 of 4 disciplines in selecting the athletes
- Must compete in one WR race series
- This award will be given to 1 female and 1 male each year
- A \$1000 scholarship will be given to each athlete to help with expenses
- Cannot be an NCAA Division 1 athlete or current or former US Ski Team Athlete
- This award can only be won once
- There is no age limit
- The award committee will also be the selection committee
- This award will be announced in September this year. Moving forward nominations will be taken in the spring and awarded at the IMD spring meeting

MSP(Brandenburg/Buchar) IMD will adopt the TRS seeding method for the U14 Tech qualifiers. This will happen when the 2 slaloms and 2 GS's are run on the same weekend. The athletes will appear on both start lists in order to make the process fair.

WR U16 December Project Discussion- This project will be a divisional project this year because it conflicts with the Sean Nurse. Once the quotas are determined by the Western Region, IMD will discuss the possibility of minimizing quotas.

Vail Project- IMD will continue to send a group to the GS Spectacular in Vail.
