Alpine Officials- Steve Schowengerdt

Becky Stone will replace Gail Barber on the IMD Alpine Officials Committee. We are still looking for a recommendation from the North to replace Mark Wedeking.

Coaches who are taking the Level 100 along with the referee course must complete two shadow experiences prior to becoming a referee. There is a shortage of Level 300 coaches that are qualified to mentor the new referees. It is possible to have multiple new referees shadow one mentor at the same time. New referees will most likely ref at U14 and older events, depending on who the TD and/or referee will be. Information on how to schedule the shadow assignments will be forthcoming.

Alpine Officials Clinics

- Competition Official, TD Update and the annual AO Update will be held via Zoom. A schedule will be coming out shortly.
- Referee courses will be offered in person along with Race Administrator, Timing and Calculations and Chief of Race.

2021-2022 Covid Protocols

- The updated Covid protocols have been published by US Ski and Snowboard. The IMD Covid Committee will be reviewing them and will issue IMD Covid protocols in October.

Coaches Education- Ben Roberts

- Non- certified coaches will be required to complete the coaches Level 100 by the spring of 2022.
- IMD will get a list of active and non-active coaches and formulate a plan to get them through the Level 100 process.
- Coaches that are able to lead a Level 100 clinic must be a Level 300 coach.
- IMD will reach out to clubs and put together a list of which clubs are planning on hosting an in-house Level 100 clinic.
- IMD will also pursue a Level 200 and 300 clinic within the division.

Race Series Information from the Development Committee

YSL

- 2 run timed event.
- Team Assignments.
- 3 races (SOL, UOP (RM), SBN).
- Teams will be assigned to race on a specific day. Assignments will be made after IMD collects projected participation numbers from the YSL Clubs.

South Series

- Weekend Racing (3 Days).
- Saturday and Sunday will be the qualifier for U12's/U10's.
- Monday will host U14's and older, not competing in the U14 series and U12's that would be better suited to race at IMD Finals.
- U14's and older may not race on the weekend.
- There will not be team seeding in the South Series.

North Series

- Weekend Racing (2 Days).
- Gender Split.
- Need details for the McCall 4 Way.

North/South Series

- Order in which the boys and girls will start on race weekends
Race #1- girls will race first
Race #2- boys will race first
Race #3- girls will race first
IMD Champs- boys will race first
- Start order for 2 races in one day consisting of 4 runs will be:
Run 1- Random draw
Run 2- Reverse first run draw
Run 3- Same as run 2
Run 4- Same as run 1

IMD Champs

- We will use the best 3 races out of 6, regardless of discipline to qualify athletes to the IMD Champs.

Speed Camp- Soldier Mountain- 1/31-2/2

- The camp will be run mid-week.
- Open to 1st year U14's.
- Discussion on whether it will be a day camp model or a team travel model. The decision will be made this fall.

Spring Series- Targhee

- This series will be a competition rather than a project (same as last season).
- 1st year U14's will have access.
- 2nd year U12's will qualify from the IMD Champs. The quota is 10 boys and 10 girls.
- 2nd Year U14's will have access in the event that they do not want to attend the Snow Cup which is scheduled at the same time.

U14

- All 2nd year U14's will have access to the Open Races.
- Tech Races will have boys and girls race in the same day.
- SG Races will be gender split.
- Snowbasin will run the girls first at the U14 SG

U16

- Tech Races will have boys and girls race in the same day.
- SG Races will be gender split.
- Jackson will run the girls first at the U16/Open SG.

Quotas

- IMD Champs- 50 boys and 50 girls from the North and the South.
- U14 Regionals- 21 boys and 20 girls.
- U16 Regionals- 31 boys and 24 girls.
- Tri-Divisionals- U16- 24 boys and 21 girls, U14- 47 boys and 48 girls.

Coaching Clinics

- IMD will create a section on the IMD website where Level 100 and 200 level clinics will be held. Clubs will need to relay this information to the division. Clubs should be prepared to allow a few participants from other clubs at their clinics if the need arises.
