Other Travel Tips

You are traveling to a foreign country (Canada) so you will need your passport. If you do not have one you will need to bring a state issued picture ID (driver's license) along with your social security card or birth certificate. If you do not have any of this you need to get an expedited passport ASAP or you will not be able to leave the airport on the 3rd.

The airlines have restricted the number and the weight of baggage, please check with your airline to find out specifics. Western Region cannot help you with any kind of a baggage waiver. The earlier you report (3-4 hours) for an international trip and the kinder you are to the baggage counter person the better chance you will have of them doing you a favor and not charging as large a fee for overweight (this is not a guarantee, but a better chance).

Please bring with you a notarized letter signed by both parents that allows you to "travel on your own to a foreign country". It is important that it states that you can travel on your own. Do NOT list any coaches because if you get separated from that coach you may not be able to continue on your travels.
