Directions to Soldier Mountain

From Ketchum:

Go south on highway 75 8 miles past Bellevue to the blinding light.

Turn right (west) on to US 20 and go to Fairfield app. 28 miles

Turn right (north) at Fairfield and follow the signs to soldier mountain. It's about 12 miles to soldier from Fairfield

It will take you 1 hour and 15 minutes to get there from Sun Valley.
