Team Captains meeting: 9:30AM at the mountain upstairs in the lodge.

All Start lists will be done before the Team Captains meeting.

Schedule of events: Sunday January 22, 2006

8:30AM	Lifts open for officials and coaches.
8:30AM	Lifts open for competitors for free skiing
10:00-10:45AM	First and second run inspection. Both courses will be set.
11:00-12:30PM	First run race for Girls followed by Boys
1PM-2:30PM	Second run race for Girls followed by Boys
Sunday PM	Awards 30 minutes after the race. Awards for each J class.

A few rules:

- Format will be single pole slalom using SPM “Hero” Gates.
- There will be no bibs, but there will be a start list posted in the lodge and at the start. Start lists will also be available for coaches and parents
- Start list will be by class, youngest to oldest and by TRS. Girls before Boys.
- 1st run DNF and DSQ’s can take their second run.
- Results will be based on racers combined times from the two runs.
- With time permitting all racers will be allowed to have additional runs for fun and practice.
- Courses will be closed to competitors. During the race.
- No skiing in the race arena.
- The race arena is a five minute easy walk from the lodge for spectating.

A few rules of the ski area:

- Attach your lift ticket to something that you will wear all day, ie: your boot, speed suit etc. No ticket, no chair lift ride.
- The mountain is open to the public, so be courteous to the other skiers. Ticket sales are available to parents and skiers at the ticket window at the front of the parking lot.
- The mountain is open for free skiing on all open areas. The terrain park is also open and is available to all skiers and snowboarders. Feel free to ski the whole mountain.
- Soldier Mountain is a small ski area. There are limited, but adequate bathroom facilities. Please be clean and courteous in the use of the bathrooms.
- Store your gear in your vehicles. The day lodge is small and open to the public.
- The upstairs bar is off limits to racers after 12PM.
