	*Our plan is to have 8-10 stubs, some terrain rollers, 6-8 GS, a small jump, and then 3-5 SG. J5's will be included. There will be 2 runs. Our Vertical drop will be 190 Meters.		
Saturday	GS	City Hill	Upper Start
	9:30 Start – Women, then Men to follow		
	* Same course for both genders. Vertical drop of 190 Meters.		
Sunday	SL	City Hill	Nastar Start
	9:30 Start – Women, then Men to follow		
	* Women on Skiers Right and Men on Skiers Left. Using 25mm Full Length poles. Vertical drop of 120 meters		

**Awards:**

30 Minutes after last racer each day at the **Finish Arena**.  
Awarding 1<sup>st</sup> – 5<sup>th</sup>, both genders, per age class (J5, J4 & J1-3), per race.

**Notes from Resort Management:**

- All athletes and coaches are to meet and register at the Training Center.
- Please do not leave bags in the Training Center.
- Coaches and parents may park in the upper lot by the Training Center.
- Skiing at excessive speeds or recklessly will result in loss of pass.
- Racers only permitted on course during inspection and race run.
- No Lift Tickets = No Lift Ride.
- Please do not attach your lift ticket to your ski boot.
- The area between the fence and Little Cat express is a SLOW skiing zone and that the rollers are to be skied slowly if at all by the racers.
- Best walking access to the race hill is from the main plaza by parking in the main parking lot.
